description

during the first few weeks of semester you will make a series of video sketches. The specific requirements of these will be available each week. Your sketches will be used as a media library for you to make an individual Korsakow film that will be published online.

It is a sketch work because:

- the video sequences will be small scale, agile, quick, and informal (sketches, not paintings)
- it is your first effort at building a multilinear, open, video work so it is about i) learning the software, ii) coming to terms with the differences that multilinear making and viewing requires, iii) a chance to make mistakes and get confused without losing lots of marks

The sketch film is to be constrained to one video window and three thumbnail images. The thumbnail images are to be still images, not video. The work is to use the 'insert text' feature to have text associated with every clip used. The sketch film will use at least twelve video clips.

learning outcomes

- how to make and publish multilinear video online
- develop ideas about how to discuss your own work
- how to make small scale, informal, media work
- develop models to think about narrative and nonfiction
